Our interdisciplinary team offers the full spectrum of care for adults with all types of seizures and epilepsy, including but not limited to:

- Focal and generalized epilepsies
- Drug-resistant epilepsy requiring surgical or device evaluation
- Epilepsy related to stroke, trauma, infection, or autoimmune disease
- Genetic or developmental epilepsies persisting into adulthood
- Adults with rare or complex syndromes, including tuberous sclerosis complex
