Overview

Our pediatric infectious diseases program provides comprehensive care for children with common, complex, or severe infections, including complicated acute cases like bone, joint, and respiratory infections, as well as chronic infections such as tuberculosis, HIV, Hepatitis B, and Hepatitis C. We treat children with congenital or perinatally acquired infections, including congenital CMV and herpes, and evaluate those with recurrent infections or fevers.

We also have a specialized immunocompromised/ transplant infectious diseases program with expertise in diagnosing and managing high-risk cases for both typical and atypical infections. This includes:

- Comprehensive infectious diseases evaluation of patients with proven or suspected underlying immunodeficiencies
- Pre-transplant screening and risk assessment in patients being evaluated for solid organ transplantation (SOT), including heart, kidney, liver, lung, or multi-visceral transplants
- Pre-transplant screening and management of chronic infections in patients undergoing hematopoietic stem cell transplant (HSCT)
